Fees Protection

Ormiston Senior College has a Fee Protection policy to safeguard the fees paid by International Students, in the unlikely event that the school may not be able to commence or continue to deliver tuition to the international student. The School's Board of Trustees guarantees to hold in reserve sufficient funds to meet the requirements of any refund in these circumstances.

Refund of Fees

International students who wish to withdraw from Ormiston Senior College must:

1. Provide written approval from their parents or agent in lieu of parents signing the leaving form.
2. Complete the college's leaving form.
3. Give homestay parents two weeks' notice if this involves terminating their homestay arrangements.

Immigration New Zealand will be informed of any changes of status of the student in relation to Ormiston Senior College.

The Refund Policy for fees of overseas students is based on Section 4B (7) of the Education Act 1989. The Principal will act as the agent of the Board of Trustees in establishing the circumstances and the level of the fees to be refunded within the spirit of this policy.
