The Ministry of Education has advised parents should be warned of the possible consequences of deliberately attempting to gain unfair priority in enrolment by knowingly giving a false addressor making an in-zone living arrangement which they intend to be only temporary. For example:

- Renting accommodation in-zone on a short term basis
- Arranging temporary board in-zone with a relative or family member
- Using the in - zone address of a relative or a friend as an "address of convenience", with no intention of living there on an ongoing basis.

If the school learns that a student is no longer living at the in - zone address given at the time of enrolment and has reasonable grounds to believe that a temporary in - zone residence has been used for the purpose of gaining enrolment at the school, the Board of Trustees may review the enrolment. Unless the parents can give a satisfactory explanation within 10 days, the Board may annul the enrolment. The course of action is provided for under Section
